Dear Parents,

Bible: This week in Bible we will be talking about Jacob marrying Leah and Rachel, Jacob's sons, Jacob flees from Laban, and Jacob wrestles with God. Our Bible memory work is Ephesians 2: 8-9, which is due this week Friday.

⁸For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – ⁹not by works, so that no one can boast.

Math: This week in math we'll continue to work with standard linear measurement. Throughout this week we will be working with perimeter and area. We'll also work on measuring equivalencies:

- 12 inches = 1 foot
- 36 inches = 3 feet = 1 yard
- 10 millimeters = 1 centimeter
- 10 centimeters = 1 decimeter
- 100 centimeters = 10 decimeters = 1 meter

Social Studies: This week we'll continue with talking about the theme of movement into, out of, and within the state of Michigan. We'll be talking about how goods, peoples, and ideas move from place to place. We'll also be talking about the fact that not everything that moves is desired. In particular, we'll be talking about how zebra muscles have come to the Great Lakes and the problems they cause.

Science: As we continue with our unit, *Earth and Me*, we'll be looking at different minerals and rocks. We'll also be looking at sand, gravel, silt, and clay. We'll see what happens to these materials when we add water to them as much as we can.

Cursive: We'll continue our cursive practice of the letters g, q, o, c.

Grammar: We will be continuing our practice with nouns. We will be identifying singular and plural nouns later on in the week.
